INTERVIEW WITH PIERRE-YVES WALDER GENERAL AND ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

WHAT VISION OF THE FANTASY GENRE ARE YOU TRYING TO PROMOTE AT THIS YEAR'S NIFFF?

An inclusive, unifying vision. We must continue to honor the foundations of a genre that wasn't always so popular, but studying its evolution – some would say mutations – is equally interesting. For a few years now, genre tropes have spilled over into many pictures that would not have been considered genre films in the past. It is thanks to such synergies that fantasy can evolve beyond its natural constraints without losing any of its power or impact. This is what we are trying to highlight this year.

WHAT ARE THE TRENDS FOR 2025?

Some themes emerged naturally during the selection process. Parenthood, for instance, is explored in new films (MOTHER'S BABY, THE THING WITH FEATHERS, CALL OF WATER, ELECTRIC CHILD) as well as in retrospective titles (DOGTOOTH, HUNGRY HEARTS). Such is also the case for mental health (TOUCH ME, A PAGE OF MADNESS, SAFE, UNSANE), the portrayal of women on screen (HER WILL BE DONE, THE GIRL IN THE SNOW), and queer representation and identities (LESBIAN SPACE PRINCESS, THE UGLY STEPSISTER). Of course, these themes are not mutually exclusive and can coexist within the same narrative.

THE NEW CAMPUS HORROR PROGRAM (SMELLS LIKE TEEN SPIRIT) EXISTS ALONGSIDE THE FOREVER YOUNG SECTION. WHAT DOES THIS SAY ABOUT THE NIFFF'S AUDIENCE OR ABOUT THE INTERGENERATIONAL REACH OF GENRE CINEMA?

The NIFFF has always had the youngest audience of all Swiss film festivals. We have been working to diversify the audience's age groups for a few years, and FOREVER YOUNG is part of that effort. This year, the three films we picked explore themes such as the passing of time, aging, and the finite nature of our existence through the lens of fantastic films. They even echo some of the features from the official selection and from the retrospective (THE HOME, RELIC). The idea behind SMELLS LIKE TEEN SPIRIT is to pay homage to an essential subgenre that has become nearly ubiquitous, namely the college campus horror movie

WHY DID YOU CHOOSE 'TAKE CARE!' AS A THEME FOR THE RETROSPECTIVE?

It felt like the logical next step after last year's retrospective. **EAT THE RICH** explored how the elites were portrayed in genre cinema, and the theme of 'care' often makes the headlines nowadays because of the abuse, injustice, and systemic violence it causes. Genre cinema is a world of infinite possibilities to explore this theme, from body horror (**RABID**)

to self-care obsession (CLUB ZERO), to mad scientists (THE BRAIN THAT WOULDN'T DIE), and hospital-set horror (COMA, INFECTION). Whether they be dark comedies or psychological thrillers, the selected films outline a particularly complex theme.

WHICH FILM FROM THE 2025 SELECTION DO YOU RECOMMEND NOT TO WATCH ALONE AT HOME AT 2 A.M.?

I'd say **CLOWN IN A CORNFIELD**, **SQUEALERS**, and **DANGEROUS ANIMALS** are not for the faint of heart. For those who wish to avoid getting really scared at NIFFF, they can refer to our 'Thrills without fear' (Frissons sans frousse) selection, a yearly guide that makes sure you won't get the heebie-jeebies.

HOW DOES THE NIFFF CONTINUE TO GO ABOUT ERASING THE BORDERS BETWEEN FILMMAKING, DIGITAL INNOVATION, TECHNOLOGY, AND GAME DESIGN?

The conferences organized as part of **NIFFF EXTENDED** are a great opportunity to stay at the forefront of innovations and the development of visual effects design techniques. This year, our guests include the teams responsible for the visual effects of the **SHOGUN** TV series and Bong Joon-ho's **MICKEY 17**. Such case studies make it easier to follow the rapid evolution of digital creation tools. The **AHEAD OF THE GAME** conference brings various Swiss game design studios together with European companies. We are also pursuing our exploration of role-playing games with the world premiere of a game developed as part of our artists-in-residence program, inspired by the works of Swiss author Magali Bossi. This project is part of a larger endeavor that will culminate with the impending opening of the Tour du fantastique.

LARGER THAN LIFE CINEMA AT HALLES OBSCURA

Exit the bleachers, enter the charm of the seats, deckchairs, and iconic terrasses of the cobblestoned Place des Halles! Our audience has named the new Open Air HALLES OBSCURA, and up to 800 people will be able to attend the festival's open-air screenings every night, several of which will be free of charge. What could possibly be better than singing along to the famous theme from GHOSTBUSTERS (Ivan Reitman, US, 1984) or to let oneself be absorbed in the mad, incandescent road movie that is WILD AT HEART (David Lynch, US, 1990) amongst other passionate cinephiles on a mild summer night?

THIS YEAR'S GUESTS

The versatile actress **Cécile de France**, whose career is a testament to her interest in genre films, will attend the NIFFF's opening ceremony to present Yann Gozlan's **THE RESIDENCE**. She also stars in **CALL OF WATER** (selected as part of the **THIRD KIND** category).

Many promising filmmakers will also be in attendance to present their first films, and others will be making their return to Neuchâtel, including Addison Heimann (TOUCH ME), the Pili team and their puppets (THUNDERBOLT FANTASY), Hélène Cattet & Bruno Forzani (REFLECTION IN A DEAD DIAMOND), as well as Lucile Hadzihalilovic (THE ICE TOWER).

This year's International Jury is a perfect representation of the festival's cross-disciplinary approach. It includes one filmmaker (John Hsu, who will be presenting his feature DEAD TALENTS SOCIETY as part of the ULTRA MOVIES section), one illustrator and one author (Emil Ferris and Jean-Baptiste Del Amo, who will be giving public conferences as part of NIFFF EXTENDED), essayist and journalist Hélène Frappat, as well as (for the first time ever) a fashion designer, namely Olivier Theyskens from Belgium.

SWISS CREATIVITY

The NIFFF continues to give the spotlight to the next generation of Swiss genre filmmakers with its short film programs as well as the **AMAZING SCHOOLS** category, dedicated to the best creations from Swiss schools.

TAKE CARE!

After **EAT THE RICH** in 2024, the NIFFF wants to focus on the theme of 'care' in genre cinema this year, through its **TAKE CARE!** retrospective, which includes 20 films that paint the portrait of societies haunted by mad doctors, bodily mutilations, and terror-inducing hospitals. The **NIFFF INVASION** and **NIFFF EXTENDED** programs will explore the same theme.

CAMPUS HORROR

The college campus has long been fertile ground for many types of fiction. It has been used as a backdrop for countless genre films and birthed many classics, becoming a subgenre in and of itself. In its honor, the NIFFF and the University of Neuchâtel (UniNE) have picked three feature films, including the seminal CARRIE, the must-see THE FACULTY, and the underseen gem WHISPERING CORRIDORS.

SHARK NIGHT

Get ready for high summer thrills and buckets of blood with a double feature of **DANGEROUS ANIMALS** (Sean Byrne, US) and **HOTSPRING SHARKATTACK** (Morihito Inoue, JP)! **SHARK NIGHT** is on!

NIFFF INVASION - FESTIVITIES EVERYWHERE

NIFFF INVASION is an entirely free program (coproduced and financed by the City of Neuchâtel) offering city-wide activities. In 2025, it will put more emphasis on children's activities, organize a writing workshop, exhibit artistic creations that explore the theme of 'care', and give the stage to many types of performances (storytelling sessions, circus shows, clown acts, theatre plays, music, parties, and so on). There's something for everyone!

NIFFF EXTENDED - WHERE REALITY AND IMAGINATION MEET

For this 24th edition, our multidisciplinary, industry-oriented, and specialized label NIFFF EXTENDED will welcome renowned guests, including French video-maker, essayist, and David Lynch expert Pacôme Thiellement, concept artist Aleksi Briclot, comic book artist Boulet, author Jean-Baptiste Del Amo, Neuchâtel-based producer and filmmaker Jean de Meuron, and author Ketty Steward. Festivalgoers will also be able to meet our distinguished guest, illustrator Emil Ferris, who will be giving an exclusive public talk.

Topics such as environmentalist fiction and questions of sustainability will also be tackled as part of two roundtable discussions.

Finally, don't miss our exclusive conferences with experts from **Aardman** (**WALLACE & GROMIT**, 2024), and VFX professionals who have worked on **MICKEY 17** (Bong Joon-Ho, 2025) and the **SHOGUN** TV series (Rachel Kondo, Justin Marks, 2024)...




